To apply for the Social Security card, bring your appointment/employment offer letter from the department/prospective employer to the UF International Center; we will then provide you with a Social Security Letter. You will then need to visit the Social Security Administration Office in order to apply. You are not able to apply for a Social Security card until you have been in the US for at least 10 days. Required application materials are:

- Passport and F-1 / J-1 Visa
- I-94 Card

- Appointment/Employment Offer Letter
- UFIC Social Security Letter
- Social Security Application Form
